CITY OF BROMLEY SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday August 30, 2022-6:00 P.M.

The City Council of the City of Bromley, Kentucky, met in a special session on Tuesday, August 30, 2022 at 6:00 P.M with Dave Radford presiding.

CALL TO ORDER

- Roll call was taken and the following members were present: Mike Kendall, Tim Wartman,

Public Hearing

City Attorney Kim Vocke brought to everyone's attention that a public notice was sent out to everyone on the proposed tax rate. Dave Radford asked if any questions need to be addressed. Citizen Katarina Marsh asked what the reference to the normal expenses in running the city were in the letter she received. Dianne Wartman made the motion to accept Ordinance 8-1-22 with a second by Tim Wartman. All members present voted yes.
- The second item on the agenda was approval of additional expense at the city's park. Tim
 Wartman presented the request in the amount of \$6,150 for a project at the park that will
 address a safety concern further explained by Mr. Wartman. Mike Kendall made the motion to
 approve the additional park expense with a second by Dianne Wartman. All members present
 voted yes.

Tim Wartman made a motion to adjourn the meeting with a second by Dianne Wartman. All members present voted yes. The meeting was adjourned at 6:10 p.m.
